

Last weekend's South East Runners event was a trail run on the bush track near Twilight Beach in windy conditions. Competitors had a choice of 2km, 5.3km or nearly 9km for the very keen.

Times were close between the top three finishers in the 2km run. Jack Sharpe led the way to finish a few seconds ahead of Adam Maccan, then Tait Voogt-Simpson.

Karen and Ian Oversby crossed the line together in the 2km walk to take out first place. In second place was Paul Sharpe, with Lauren Smith just pipping her older sister Ellie to finish third.
